
DON'T GIVE UP THE SHIP

On June 1, 1813 a spirited battle was fought between the USS Frigate Chesapeake and the HMS Shannon. As a mortally wounded Captain James Lawrence was being carried below, he admonished Chesapeake's crew. "Tell the men to fire faster! Don't give up the ship!"

The Chesapeake eventually struck her colors and Shannon took her as a prize. Lawrence did not survive. The British navy was victorious that day off the coast of Massachusetts, dealing the US Navy a stunning blow.



But Lawrence's sentiment lived on. Later that year Commodore Oliver Hazard Perry had a flag made with those immortal words emblazoned upon it. He first flew it on the USS Lawrence (named after his friend) and later on the USS Niagara, transferring the flag and his command by long boat at the climax of the battle. Inspired by Lawrence's words, the US Navy prevailed that September day. It was the Battle of Lake Erie...fought over 200 years ago in our own home waters. "We have met the enemy and they are ours: two ships, two brigs, one schooner and a sloop."



"Don't give up the ship" eventually became the motto and rallying cry of the United States Navy. This is the last "Skulldugger" column that I will write as your Commodore. It has been an honor and privilege to serve as your Commodore this past year. Lady Mary and I are truly blessed to be members of this wonderful club and to count you all as friends. But why, you ask, do I write about a historical incident that took place 210 years ago.

Like Lawrence, I have some parting words for my "crew". You are the best, brightest, friendliest, and hardest working people that I have ever known. Outside of my family, the relationship that I have shared with the members of the Jolly Roger Sailing Club has been the most important of my life.

draft, make her a good fit for the dock system at JRSC. Asking \$2500 obo. Please see Diane Silas for more info or call 517-581-9245










